The origin of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences can be traced back to the 19th century. Based on the first lectures on agricultural chemistry around 1800, new scientific fields in agronomy, animal production and farm management were developed. The Faculty of Agricultural Sciences was founded in 1952 as the seventh Faculty of the Georg-August-Universität and is one of the largest research-oriented agricultural faculties in Germany today.

The research and teaching profile of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences is characterized by a system oriented approach towards the agricultural land use in temperate, tropical and subtropical regions. This comprehensive research and teaching standard can be offered by the Faculty based on the broad spectrum of available natural and social science institutes within the faculty.

Founded in 1737, the University of Göttingen is internationally renowned for its long research tradition and its remarkable range of disciplines. In 2007 it was recognized as one of the top nine universities in Germany for its high research level and future strategy.
