



## CERORGANIC EUROPEAN CONFERENCE ON Organic Agriculture & Education: Challenges in Training Advisors of Organic Farmers

## Conference Venue - Institute of Agricultural Sciences (IGE)

The CerOrganic European Conference will take place at the premises of the Institute of Agronomic Sciences (IGE). IGE is located at 182 Kifissias Av., Kifissia. IGE premises are easily accessible by public means of transportation:

- i. By Metro Line 1 (ISAP Green line): From Omonoia square you can take the metro line 1 towards Kifissia and you get off at KAT station. When you exit the KAT station, you will take Thessalonikis road on your right hand, until you meet Athinas street. Then you will have to walk down Athinas street, until you meet Kifissias Avenue. After walking to the opposite side of Kifissias Av.using the pedestrian lane you will see the entrance of the IGE premises. From there you will only have to follow the signs leading you to the Conference room.
- ii. By using a bus: You can take bus A7 from Kaniggos square and get off at KAT station. The route with bus can take a long time, due to the heavy traffic.

iii. By taxi: In case you take a taxi, you should tell to the taxi driver to drive you at the Instituuto Geoponikon Epistimon (IGE), near Ktima Syggrou (Kifissias 182, Kifissia). It will cost you about €20 from the center of Athens.





## **Public transportation**

## From the airport:

The airport is connected to the center of Athens by means of metro, suburban railway, buses and taxis. The most convenient and fast way of reaching Hotel Athinais and DIO premises is by Metro. There is a metro from the airport to the hotel every 30 minutes, the ticket costs €8,00 and is valid for 90 minutes after its validation. You may use the same ticket while changing means (e.g. metro, bus etc.) without having to validate it again.

A taxi will cost you about €35 from the airport to the center of Athens (fixed price for daytime – during the night the cost is €50) but the trip may take a long time due to the traffic near the center of Athens.

For trips within Athens (e.g. all metro and bus stations apart from the Airport), the metro ticket costs €1,40 and is valid for 90 minutes from its validation. More information is available in English:




Figure 2: Athens city centre Metro Map
