About JOI.CON

JOI.CON: Joint Programme Management – Conferences and Training was selected by the European Commission as an ERASMUS Accompanying Measure in 2011. The 1-year project is coordinated by the University of Leipzig and supported by further 7 European universities and 2 networks. It aims at training future coordinators of Joint Programmes by steering them through the administrative processes related to implementing Joint Programmes on Master and Doctoral level. JOI.CON understands Joint Programmes as study programmes leading towards either a double or a joint degree.

JOI.CON is an offspring of the JOIMAN project. Therefore, the widely absorbed findings of JOIMAN shape the milestones of JOI.CON. Those milestones are two international conferences and an embedded training, more specifically a Joint Programme simulation. The first conference took place on January 18th, 2012, in Leipzig. It also marked the beginning of the JOI.CON training phase. Participants of the JP simulation were set off in teams to create fictive Joint Programmes in the period from January until June 2012. On the 13th of June 2012, they will present their results at the second JOI.CON conference in Bologna. All findings will finally be published in a public report.
