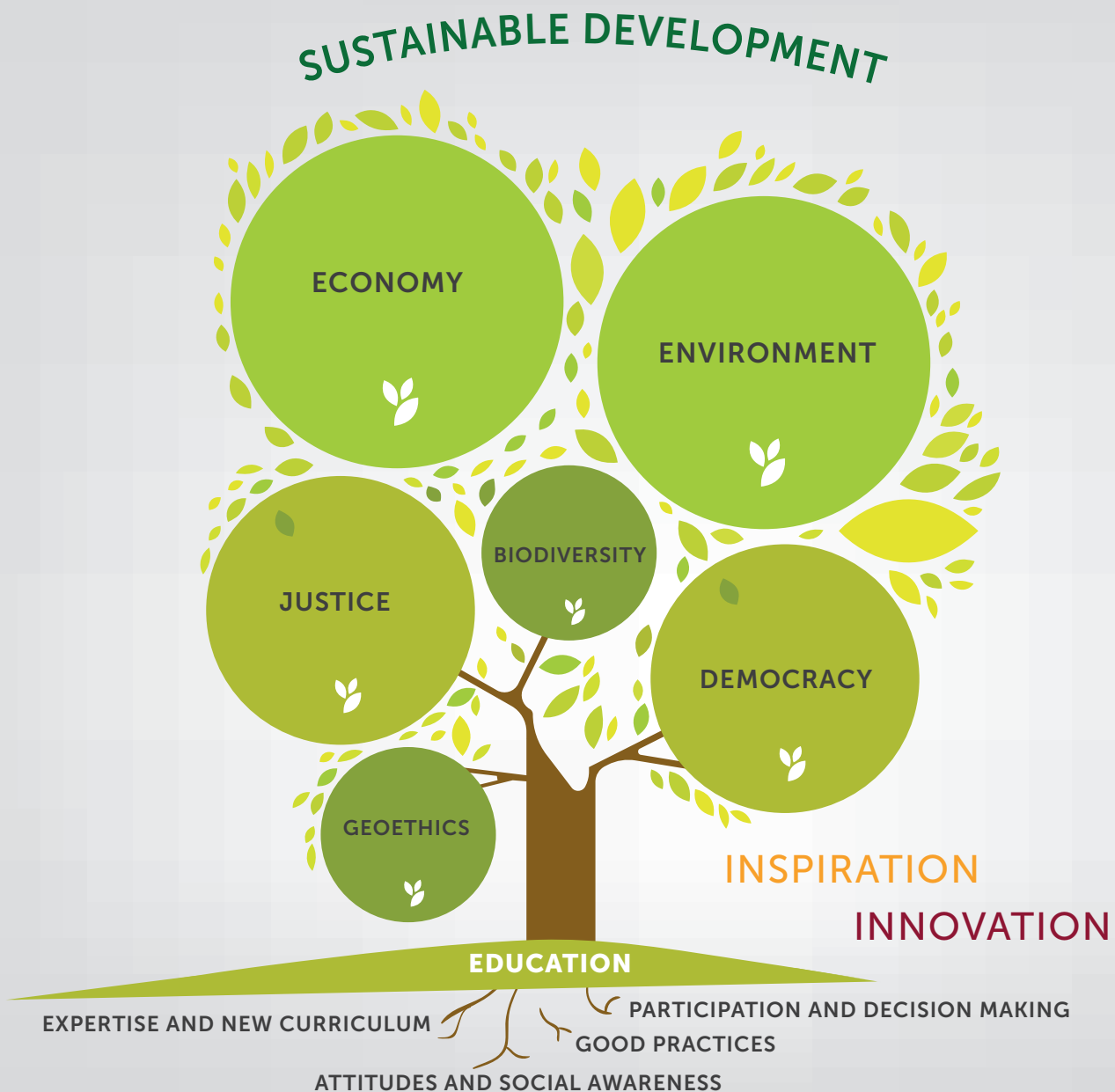


WISE, Erasmus + Strategic Partnership project, is aimed at:
